- A history of the Civilian Conservation Corps, the work relief program which sponsored jobs through land improvement projects during the Great Depression at places such as Promised Land State

CCC Day is an annual event which honors work done by men of the CCC who planted trees, built cabins, and watched for forest fires. The Masker Museum is located at Promised Land State Park.

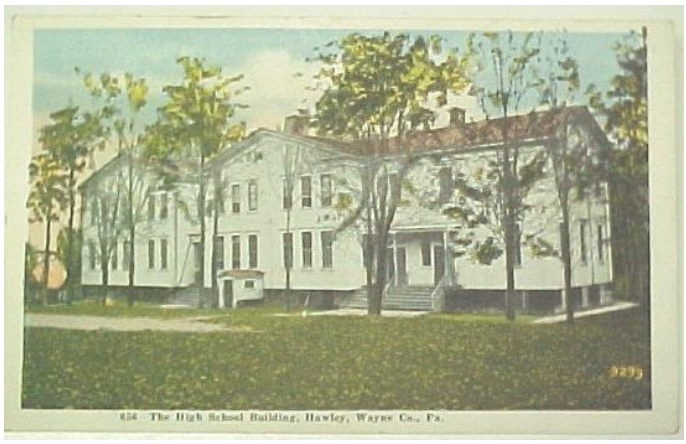
